SafetyBeltSafe U.S.A. has at least 1 copy of each of the audiovisuals listed except those marked with "+". Other sources are listed by some audiovisuals. To use our Audiovisual Library, users can pick up and return the items or cover UPS charges (\$5-8).

NOTE: Recent incidents of parents being shown videos made prior to the advent of passenger air bags should alert all safety advocates to screen materials for inclusiveness. However, on occasion, a video which is somewhat outdated can be used IF the newer information is emphasized both before and after the screening. Anyone using older items needs to be clear about the possible gaps in information. In the listing below, "**H**" before a title means mainly of **Historical Interest**. Some items made long ago are still relevant but may not show current products or present all of the warnings that would be included in current teaching formats. The SafetyBeltSafe Audiovisual Library, also founded in 1980, has a wide range of older videos no longer listed but available for research purposes.

Are We There Yet? (VHS) 11 mins. by SAFE KIDS BUCKLE UP. Good review of basics of buckling up from birth to teen years. Doesn't show varied belt systems nor comparison of loose and tight belts/harnesses in crash situation.

Baby Care Basics for Breastfeeding Mothers. (VHS) includes 15 mins. of Seat Belts and the Family (GM and AMA) from Ross Labs.

The Baby-Safe Home. (VHS) 49 min. by Eagle/Horowitz Productions. Horowitz covers prevention of major injury threats for young children.

Car Seat Safety, Providing A Safer Ride for Your Child. (VHS) 10 mins by Fisher-Price. Good review of how to choose and use a safety seat by Lorrie Walker, Pennsylvania American Academy of Pediatrics. Only one brand of safety seat and doesn't show diverse belts.

Children in Crashes. (VHS) 8 mins. by Insurance Institute for Highway Safety (IIHS). Covers importance of correct, consistent use of car seats; shows crashed cars in which children died or were saved.

Children's Miracle Network, Parenting Poll 1992 Telethon. (VHS) 82-min. review of most important issues on parents' minds, beginning with child passenger safety. Includes 30-sec. spot by S.M. Tombrello on correct use.

Don't Risk Your Child's Life! VII. (VHS in English and Spanish) 19 min. by Shelness Productions. Crash protection for child passengers, air bag footage, restraint types, compatibility between seats and belts. Technically excellent.

It's A Lifesaver. (VHS) 21-1/2 min. by KidSafe of Texas. English and Spanish versions. Why and how of child passenger safety incorporated in a story.

Protecting Your Newborn. (VHS) 26 mins by National Highway Traffic Safety Administration. Introduction to passenger safety for prenatal groups and parents of newborns. Includes information on various safety belt systems.

Ready to Go. (VHS) 3-segment review of how to use a) Dream Ride car bed/infant seat; b) TLC infant-only seat; c) Touriva 5-point harness convertible seat. Available in Spanish.

Safety. A Guide to Making Baby's World A Safer Place. (VHS) 9 mins. by Mead Johnson Nutritional Div. A brief overview of chief injury-causing risks for infants.

Traveling Safely: Using Your Child Safety Seat. (VHS) 8 min. by University of Georgia Cooperative Extension Service. Shows how to use a safety seat in a vehicle. Entirely in American Sign Language and Captions in English. Meant for the hearing impaired.

Be Safe on Your Bike. (16mm, VHS) 13 mins. by Forrest F. Wilkins, LAPD. A video emphasizing helmet use for everything from everyday riding to cycling at a velodrome. Great for elementary and up. Borrow VHS from SafetyBeltSafe U.S.A.

Human Cargo -- A Deadly Way to Go! (VHS in English or Spanish) 5 mins. by Pediatric Injury Prevention Group. Shows clearly the dangers of riding in the cargo area of pickup trucks, the personal consequences, and the way to refuse to transport others unsafely.

Mickey Mouse: Safety Belt Expert. (VHS in English or Spanish) 15 mins. by Disney Educational Productions. Shows youngsters and Mickey teaching adults to buckle up all ages. Purchase from Coronet Distributing (800) 621-2131.

Otto the Auto. (16 mm) 4 min. film by AAA Foundation for Traffic Safety. Focus on primary school age children.
